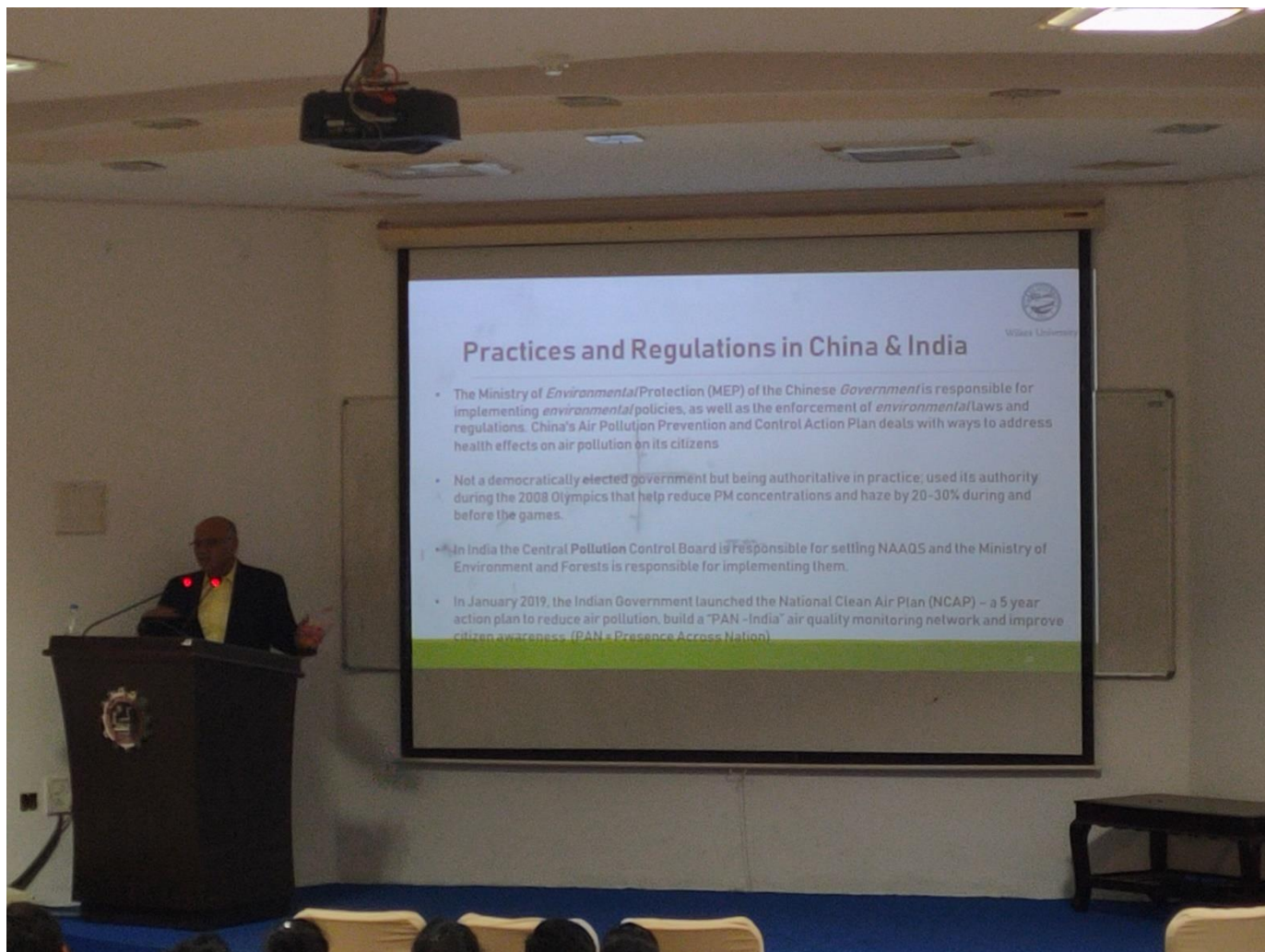

## Practices and Regulations in China & India

- The Ministry of Environmental Protection (MEP) of the Chinese Government is responsible for implementing environmental policies, as well as the enforcement of environmental laws and regulations. China's Air Pollution Prevention and Control Action Plan deals with ways to address health effects on air pollution on its citizens
- Not a democratically elected government but being authoritative in practice; used its authority during the 2008 Olympics that help reduce PM concentrations and haze by 20-30% during and before the games.
- In India the Central Pollution Control Board is responsible for setting NAAQS and the Ministry of Environment and Forests is responsible for implementing them.
- In January 2019, the Indian Government launched the National Clean Air Plan (NCAP) – a 5 year action plan to reduce air pollution, build a "PAN -India" air quality monitoring network and improve citizen awareness. (PAN = Presence Across Nation)
