

## GUEST LECTURE ON GROUND WATER CONSERVATION

Department of Civil Engineering has organized a guest lecture on 18 Feb 2015 at Jasmine Hall, KL University. As a resource person, Mr. A. Vara Prasadgaru Deputy director of Ground Water Department, Vijayawada.

Mr. A. Vara Prasadgaru explained the importance of water, various methods of conservation to save water bodies; he also enlightened the students regarding their carrier. He explained about the value of the water, the problems which are going to be faced by the future generations, if we continue the wastage of natural resources.

Natural resources occur naturally within environments that exist relatively undisturbed by mankind, in a natural form. A natural resource is often characterized by amounts of biodiversity and geodiversity existent in various ecosystems.

The youth who benefit from the message of water conservation should take up the responsibility of spreading the message.

Giving some startling facts he said that 45 litres of water is wasted if a tap is left running while a person brushes teeth. Similarly 48 litres was wasted if water was left running while shaving and a startling amount of 18 litres was wasted while a person washed hands, he said. All this water could be saved by using a mug while performing these chores he said.
