

## **Institutional Repository**

Research publications are the result of intense R&D efforts made by the researcher who strives hard to add new knowledge to the existing world knowledge. This is done by way of research or review papers, project reports, conference papers, chapters to books, etc. All academic and research institutions publish research. This intellectual capital is to be archived and preserved. One way of doing it is creating Institutional Repository (IR) of the Institution. The IR covers publications by the Faculty, Research Scholars, and Staff in the form of published research papers, book chapters, conference papers, project reports, etc.

These publications should be collected, scanned or digitized and hosted in the IR on the institution's website. The knowledge capital thus archived in the IR will create knowledge base for the institution, have greater visibility to scientific community at large on a global scale, get downloaded by more researchers and so receive larger number of citations than printed articles, and would attract the attention of Project Funding Agencies. Scholars and Faculty as well as students will get motivated to contribute more to the institutional knowledge base.

The articles and contributions of the IR should be hyperlinked to the web pages of the respective Departments of the Authors making their web pages full with R&D material.
