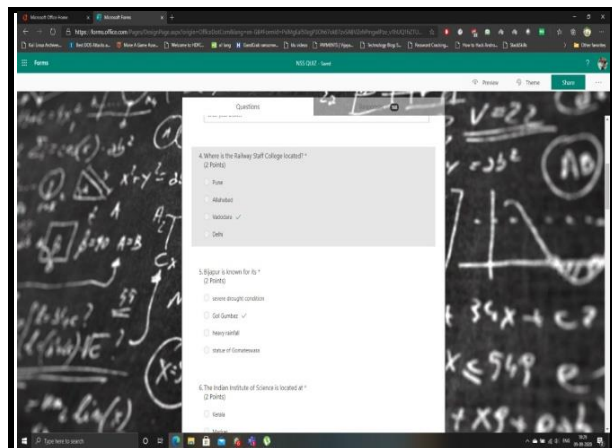
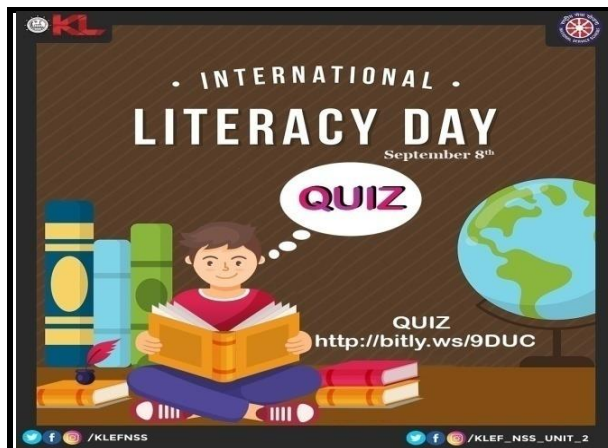

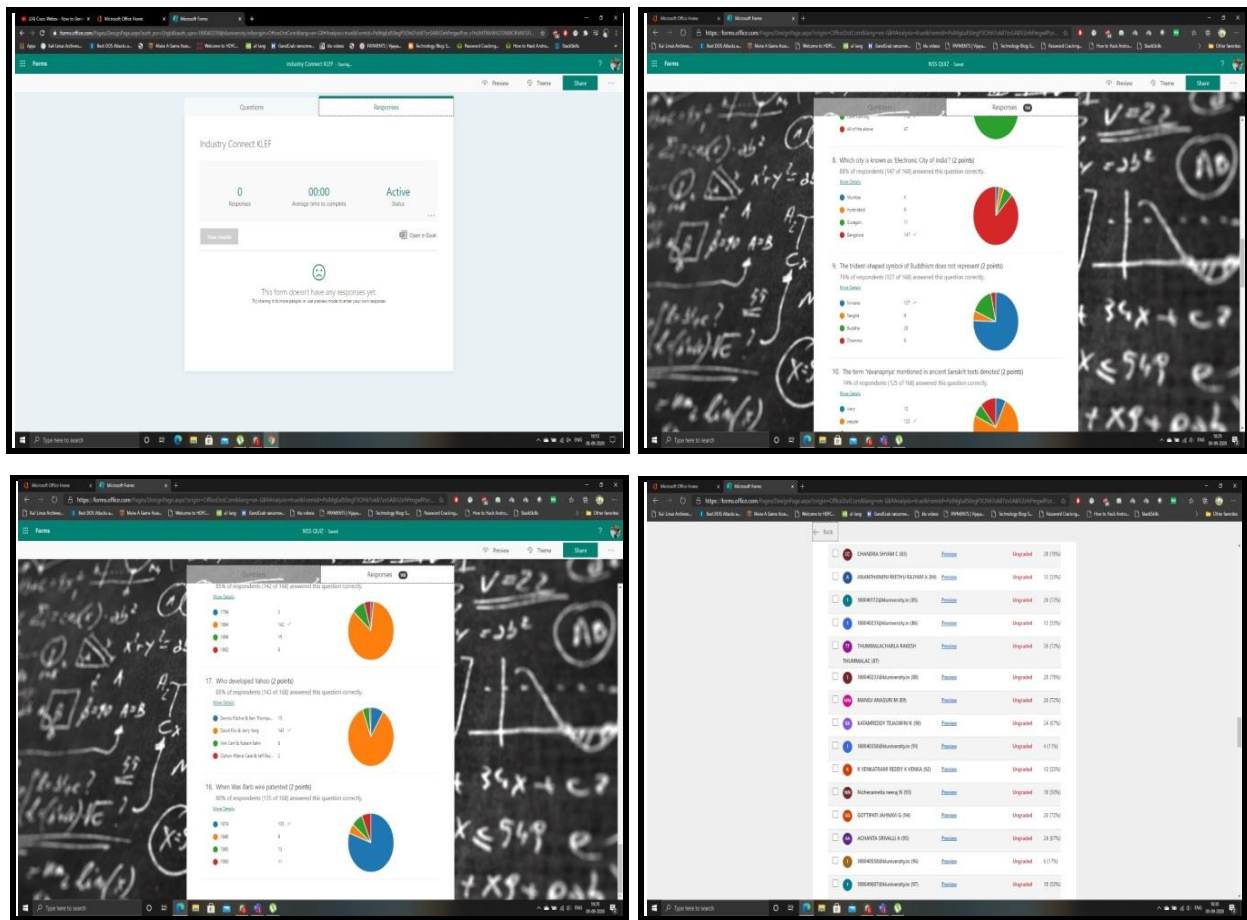
Name of the Event: International Literacy Day
