Some of the villagers interacted with the volunteers during the survey and shared their feelings and problems with them. Our volunteers listened to their problems and made them feel comfortable so as to make them happy by giving a hope that they will pass all the problems in the village to the Panchayat & Govt. to take necessary actions in order to solve the problems in the village.

#### **Points that are enlisted during Survey:**

Residential status, Type of house’, Source of drinking water, Source of cooking Fuel, Toilets, Source of income, Mode of Wages/income, Hygiene around the house (overview), No of people in the house, No of adults in the house (above 60), No of children in the house (<15), Type of study of Children, No of women in house, No of illiterates, No of unemployed youth, Had Health checkup in last 6 months, Internet usage, Do u have a Bank account?, Do u have an ATM Card, Card usage?, How frequent u visit bank monthly?, Paytm or mobile wallets.

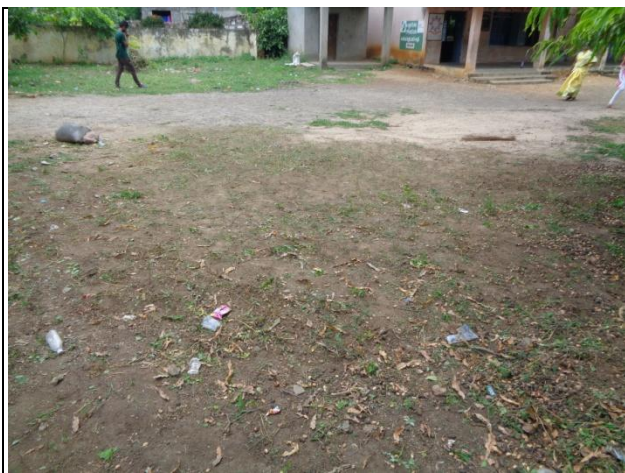

## **Organ Donation Registrations**

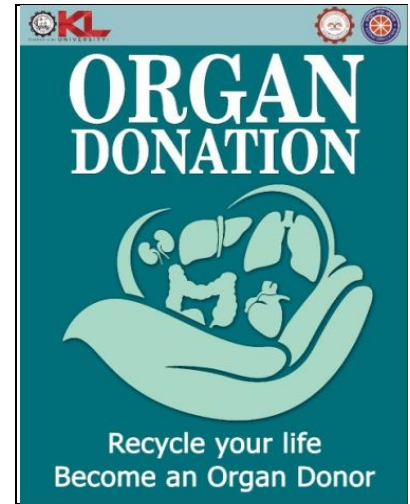
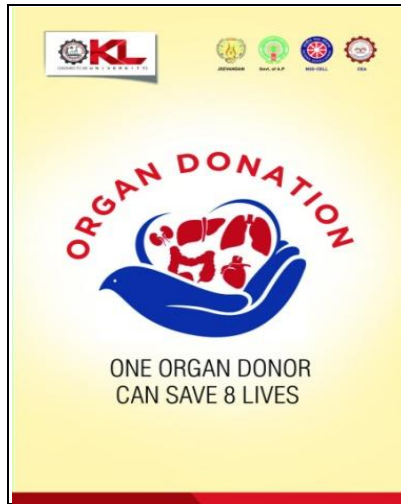
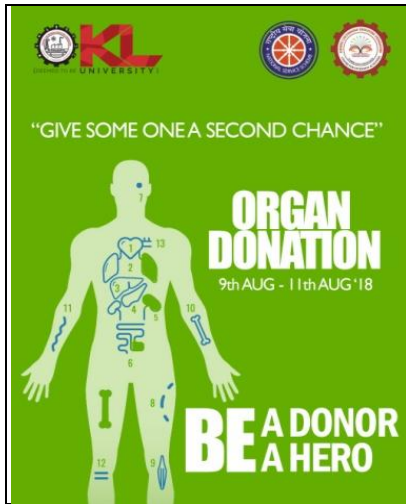
KL Deemed to be University – National Service Scheme in collaboration with CEA organized an event named “Organ Donation Registrations” in the University for three days i.e., from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> of this month. Every 12 minutes, another person’s name joins the 123,000 others on the national organ transplant waiting list. A single organ donor can save up to eight lives. 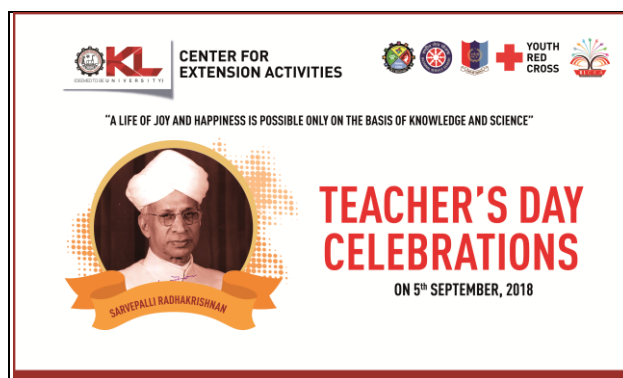
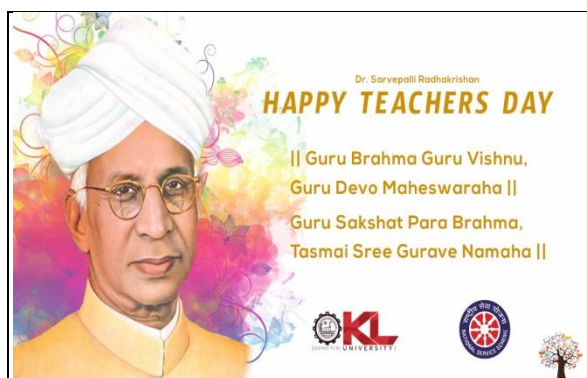

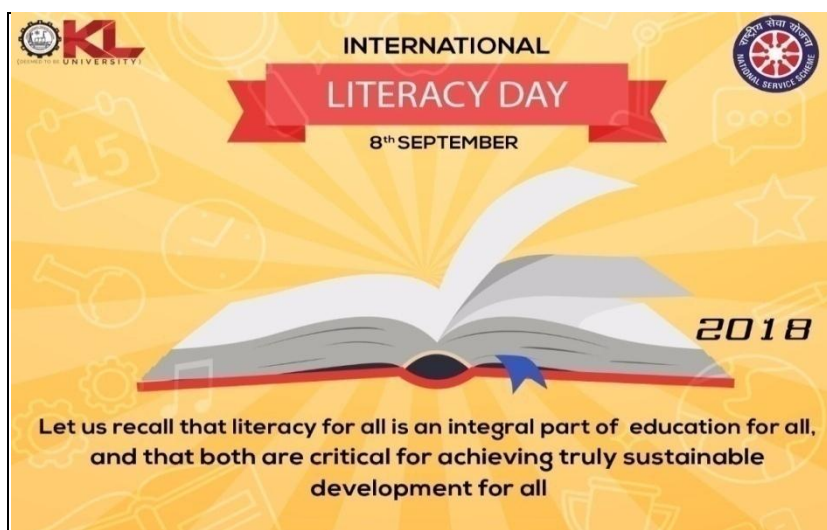
## **World Literacy Day**

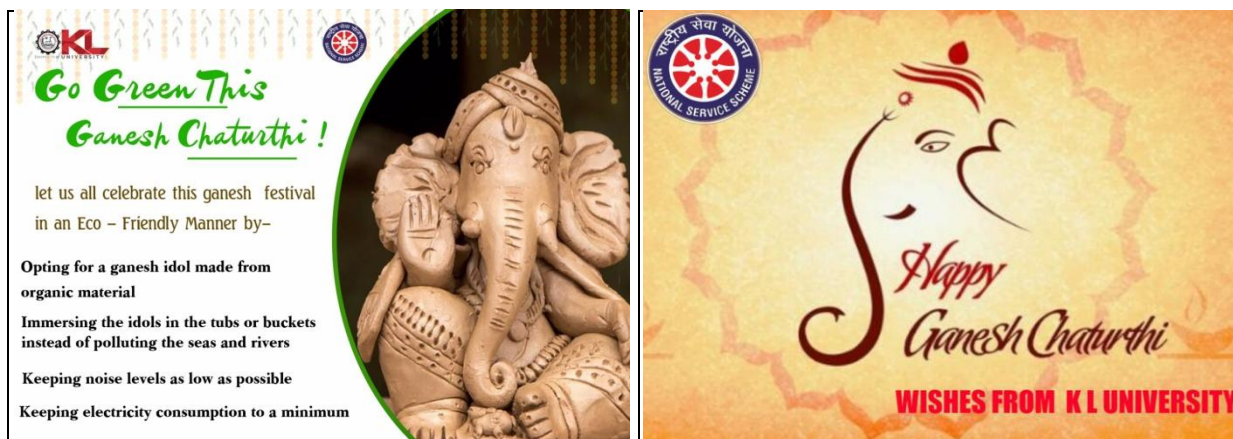

**Plantation and Rally on Domala Pi Dandhayatra**

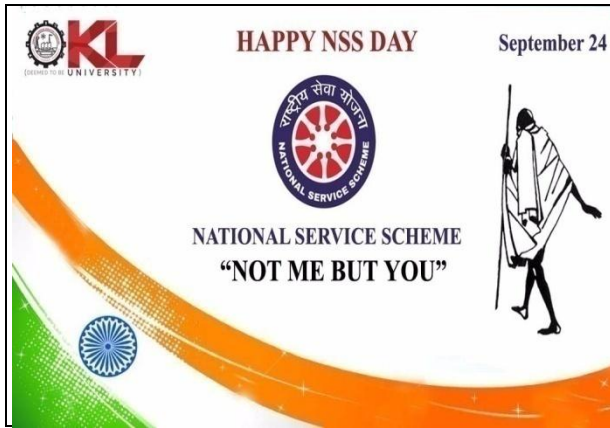

And the villagers might not have the good levels of hemoglobin. Our students verified their level of hemoglobin and given precautions if anyone has the low level of it.

**Eye checkup:** Doctors from **Sky Health Foundation** tested the eyes of villagers who had some problems regarding eyes. The doctors had given the medicines and eye drops bottle as per their problems. If it's a severe situation they insisted them to visit their clinic and they will do operation. Old persons may have the problem of cataract so it can be solved only by operation.

**Heart related checkup:** Two Cardiologists from NRI Hospital, Vijayawada participated in the camp and rendered their services. At first the Nurses tested the BP's of villagers and sent them to doctors. The doctors tested them and asked their problems while working (Asthma) or sleeping (snoring) or cough and cold problems. They had written medicines as per their problems. If they are severe issues like scanning, doctors said to visit their hospitals and assured that they will treat them. If they have the Arogya Sri card, they are treated freely.

**ECG Checkup:** An electrocardiogram (ECG) is a test which measures the electrical activity of your heart to show whether or not it is working normally. The doctors checked them and given reports immediately.

## Medical Camp

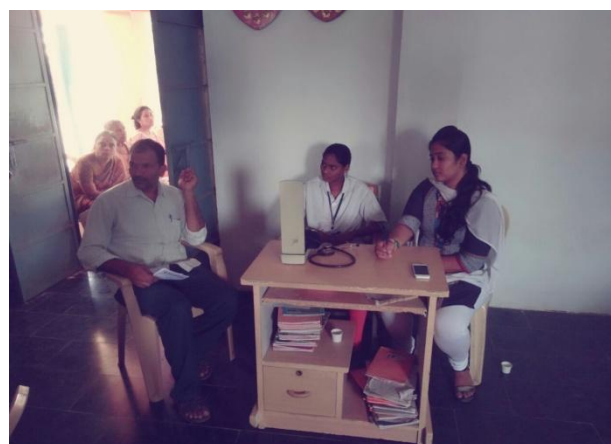

### **Summary of the event**

It is a shocking fact that more than one lakh people are killed in India every year in Road accidents. This is about 10% of the total deaths across the world is due to Road accidents. This indicates the high exigency to fight against Road accidents in every possible way and create awareness on road safety measures and precautions to be taken by every citizen in India in order to prevent accidents on Indian roads and save many lives. Understanding the fact that the Road Safety is not only the shared concern but also the shared responsibility of the Government and a range of social activists like Media, NSS, NGO's and every common man in the society. As this includes many points, mainly focused on “HELMET USAGE” to protect ourselves from accidents even if they had happened “A helmet aids the skull in protecting the human brain.”

It is better not to crash at all, then to crash wearing a helmet. But if you do crash, a helmet works to absorb the force, which protects your head, which in turn protects your brain. Helmets work to prevent head injuries which become even more important for children whose brains are still developing. As part of our program we visited a petrol bunk in Tadepalli where we can find many people at any time. We had designed many placards with some slogans which resembles use of helmet and follow traffic rules.

The aim was to come face to face with the city road users and inform them how they can take basic care and protection by wearing helmets and seat belts for their own good. The main target commuters however were the motorcycles/scooter/moped users who are more prone to injuries and fatality in case of an accident.

- ⇒ Placards play a major role because pictures convey more information in less time than words.
- ⇒ We approached daily commuters and provided vital information about the helmet. The emphasis was not just to tell everyone how important and lifesaving it can be to wear a helmet but to make them understand how equally important it is to buy only and only good quality ISI or DOT marked helmets.
- ⇒ We complimented those who are wearing helmets with a chocolate and asked them to use regularly and insist their neighbors to use it.

- ⇒ Our team also gave information about “traffic rules” and also said that the best way to keep others and yourself safe is to follow proper traffic rules.

Whenever you drive a car or bike follows the traffic rules, it is important to wear helmet while driving a two wheeler, obey the traffic lights to avoid accidents.

One should always wear seat belt while driving a car. Avoid rash driving as fast speed is the core reason of accidents. Always carry all the paper of the vehicle.

- ⇒ We also insisted car passengers to wear seatbelts and its use. Seatbelts can save your life in a crash and can reduce your risk of a serious injury. Seat belts keep drivers and passengers from being ejected through windows or doors.
- ⇒ They are important safety features, like air bags, help to protect a driver or passenger in a collision and minimize injuries. Those who don't wear their seatbelts while in a vehicle put themselves at greater risk of severe injury or even death
- ⇒ This campaign carried out by our lads and we hope that we managed to change the outlook of the commuters towards their own safety to some extent, if not drastically.
- ⇒ Our main motto of the event is **“Be aware and also aware others”**
- ⇒ The main reason behind spreading traffic rule awareness is to make people realize the loss they have occurred due to accidents they cause, with their ignorance to traffic rule.

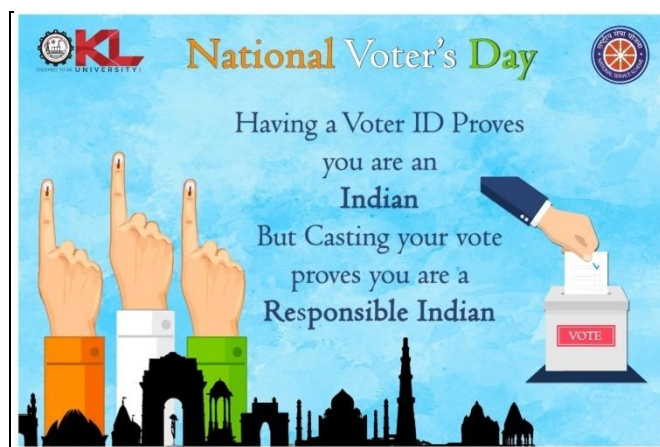
## **Voter and Polio Awareness**

Ramaiah) and 7 faculty from CSE department are involved. On the day of the event, all the NSS volunteers, NSS program officer and seven faculty of the Computer Science Department along with 25 volunteers started from the college at 10.00 am in bus and reached the Chirravuru by 10.30 am.

**Objective:** 25<sup>th</sup> January is celebrated as National Voters Day as in 1950 on the same day Election Commission of INDIA established. The aim of the event is increasing the enrolment of voters, especially encourage participation of newly eligible young voters and ensure universal adult franchise.

### **Summary of the event**

Being a citizen of the democratic country like INDIA where we get to choose our government and leaders. Our parliament and legislatures are of the people, by the people and for the people. Voting is a constitutional right that we are privileged to have. It's even more important to vote considering you (every citizen) are the one that leads to change. The right to vote is the foundation of a healthy, functioning democracy. The ballot is your voice. It is the most powerful tool at your disposal to not only affect change in your neighborhood or state, but to create a better India. In recent days a lot of us are not stepping out to do it as they think “Is my single vote going to change the country” and many people sit back and relax on voting day, on the other hand simply sits and complains about this and that and makes suggestions that the government should change this and that.



As a part of our event we the NSS volunteers stepped forward to spread the word about the importance of voting and the right to vote. We divided into groups which consists 3

members and spread across village. We motivated the villagers of pedapalem to vote and cast their vote righteously. And those who are not yet applied for voter card, we insisted them to do it as soon as possible. We conducted the program with an aim to increase the average voting percentage in the state. We also put focus over the fact that collective decision through voting help us to elect a good leader which is not only useful for ourselves but for nation also.

Volunteers urged villagers to vote and make the people who stay around them to cast their vote in the interest of the country. We told them that “Every Vote Counts” and make use of it compulsorily. We also filled one Google form for each home with their data and made a note of them so that we can make any help to them in future.



#### Interacting with villagers and noting information

Along with Voter’s awareness we also educated them regarding the Pulse Polio Immunization program which will be conducted in first week of February. We insisted them to utilize the opportunity and keep their children healthy. With the global initiative of eradication of polio (poliomyelitis) in 1988 following World Health Assembly resolution in 1988, Pulse Polio Immunization program was launched in India in 1995. Children in the age group of 0-5 years administered polio drops during National and Sub-national immunization rounds (in high risk areas) every year. Around 17.4 core children of less than five years across the country are given polio drops as part of the drive of Government of India to sustain polio eradication from the country.

We informed that “polio is a viral infection that will cause permanent paralysis every baby child should get the polio vaccine in four doses of IPV (inactivated poliovirus vaccine) or OPV (oral polio vaccine). The younger the baby, higher is the risk of getting the infection. The polio drops increases the capacity of babies to resist the infection or disease and after five years they will have less chances to get infected”.

We visited the Anganwadi School and interacted with the teachers, she assured that, she definitely takes all children of the school and gets polio drops and vaccination. We advised them that “It's all of our responsibility to prevent polio from affecting our children and letting them grow with full potential. New parents must join hands in eliminating polio virus from India and the world by giving polio vaccine and by spreading the awareness about it”

The patient's body can start producing antibodies that attack the antigens on the blood cells in the blood that was given to the patient. Many villagers came to know their blood group and we had given an identity card so that they will never forget.
