Minutes of Meeting of 47th IQAC Advisory Committee Meeting Held "Online – Webex" on 02.05.2024, from 3:00 pm In Chair: Dr. G. P. S. Varma, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KLEF

The 47th Advisory Committee Meeting by Internal Quality Assurance Cell, KLEF was held on 02.05.2024.

Dr. G. P. S. Varma, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KLEF chaired the meeting. Dr. Varma, in his foreword, welcomed all attendees and appreciated rigorous efforts put in by the IQAC and all functionaries, in submitting the SSR-Cycle 3 to NAAC on 29th April 2024. He informed the members that the Student Satisfaction Survey has already commenced, which will be followed by DVV later this month. The Dean (Quality) recalled the words of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in this regard and informed the members that IIQA was approved on 1 March 2024. SSR for NAAC 3rd Cycle was submitted on 29 April 2024. Two external experts verified and vetted the documents before they were uploaded in the NAAC Portal. Student Satisfaction Survey has already commenced which will be followed by DVV later this month. As could be seen, KLEF scored lower marks in 2024 under Citations (68.4 to 54.4) and under Industry income (37.2 to 16.6). The number of papers published under Q1 Journals could be the reason for lower score under Citations; similarly non-commercialization of KLEF patents has resulted in lower score under Industry income.

There are about 5000 trees in the Green Fields campus and the process of providing name plates containing Botanical names of individual trees has begun.

<u>Agenda Item 2</u>: Postponement of 2-day National Conference on Quality Issues to July 2024

The Dean-Quality informed the members that the 2-day Conference was supposed to take place during February-March every year; it was postponed due to the hectic task of SSR-Cycle 3 Submission, which took place on 29th April 2024. He suggested organizing this rescheduled Conference, IAQHEI-2024 during the 1st – 2nd weeks of July 2024. Exact dates shall be decided later this month.

<u>Agenda Item 3</u>: Enhancing ERP functionality to streamline report generation for diverse needs.

The Dean-Quality informed the members that IQAC would like the ERP to have the following facilities for making the monthly audits less cumbersome:

- > Department IQAC Monthly report generation in ERP.
- Provision for recording IQAC Audit comments by auditors and forwarding to respective functionary.
- > Provision for functionary to give compliance.

This would save considerable amount of time besides providing necessary data to the top management at the click of a button.

The EQUIS stands for The European Quality Improvement System, which is the accrediting body of the European Fund for Management Development (EFMD) and is dedicated to raising the standard of management education worldwide. EQUIS Accredited Business Schools in India include top IIMs like IIM Ahmedabad, IIM Bangalore, IIM Kozhikode, and Indian School of Business (ISB), to name a few.
