The Indian constitution is the pride of its citizens. The document lays down the framework demarcating fundamental political code, structure, procedures, powers, and duties of government institutions and sets out fundamental rights, directive principles of state policy and the duties of citizens. It is the longest written constitution of any country on Earth. Dr.B.R.Ambedkar, the chairman of the drafting committee, is widely considered to be its chief architect.

The Constitution of India came into force on 26th January, 1950. At the time of its adoption, the Constitution contained 395 Articles and 8 Schedules and was about 145,000 words long, making it the longest national Constitution to ever be adopted. Every article in the Constitution was debated by the members of the Constituent Assembly, who sat for 11 sessions and 166 days to frame the Constitution, over a period of 2 years and 11 months. The constitution declares India a sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic, republic, assuring its citizens justice, equality and liberty and endeavors to promote fraternity.
