SPECIAL CAMP-WE SERVE THE DESERVE

Door to door survey in Vaddeswaram Village

A survey regarding health problems and general things in vaddeswaram village was done to find and understand the basic problems and needs of the villagers. There was good interaction with the villagers by all the volunteers. During survey NSS volunteers got useful information regarding Education, Sanitation, Anganwadi, Maintenance and Infrastructure, the major health problem in the village etc. At the end of the first day, the team gathered and discussed the day's activity and the results of the survey.

Together, for campaign calling for a better future for children in vaddeswaram

The campaign is aiming to raise awareness about the migrant children's efforts progress and resilience, highlighting the significance of formal and non formal education as an enabling platform that allows them to integrate into the society quickly and successfully. The campaign also addressed the importance of a safe and inclusive environment in their everyday lives.

Showcasing the positive outcomes of inclusive and quality learning for migrant children in vaddeswaram and conducted academic games and distributed educational resources to 450 poor students.

Visit to Govt Primary School to Vaddeswaram

On the second day of the camp, NSS students visited government primary school. NSS students motivated the children by involving them in their classes and tried to explain the importance of education. Career guidance sessions are conducted for high school children. Encouraged the school students to participate in cultural activities and sports. Some inspirational stories were narrated to the students. The students participated with great interest and involved in all the activities with enthusiasm. Few inspirational and academic books are donated to the school.

Save Water Awareness Programme

Water, being a scarce resource and a primary one, should not get wasted. Lot of people has shortage of water supply. As a part of this our volunteers have taken an initiative to create awareness in vaddeswaram village by conducting a rally and motivated households. Slogans like “Save water Save lives” were given by the volunteers.

Medical Camp

On the final day of the camp, a free medical check-up camp was conducted. Doctors provided free service to the villagers. A good response was observed from the medical check-up camp and about 70 villagers consulted doctors. Villagers were treated and the required medicines were given free of cost. The volunteers have taken an active part in helping doctors to make the medical check-up camp successful and the also the villagers-maintained cooperation with us.

Computer Usage and Importance

In the afternoon session a few volunteers went to school and given presentation regarding computer usage and its importance. Computers are used in so many fields in our daily life. From Engineers to Doctors, Students, Teachers, and Government organisations they all use computers to perform specific tasks, for entertainment or just to finish office work.
