A Report on Survey on Seasonal Diseases

Conducted on 25-09-2021 at Chirravuru

Objective:

The objective of the Survey on Seasonal Diseases conducted on 25-09-2021 at Chirravuru was to assess the prevalence of seasonal illnesses among residents and identify common health issues faced during specific times of the year. The survey aimed to gather data on symptoms, frequency, and affected demographics to guide healthcare interventions and promote community health awareness.

Description:

On 25-09-2021, KL Deemed to be University's Computer Science Engineering (CSE) Unit-07 National Service Scheme (NSS) conducted a "Survey on Seasonal Diseases" at Chirravuru village, Tadepalli Mandal, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh. Given the rising incidence of seasonal diseases like Malaria and Dengue, our team initiated an awareness program to address these health concerns in the village. Mr. P. Srikanth Reddy, Programme Coordinator of KLEF NSS Cell, and Programme Officer of Unit-07, Mrs. P. Yellamma, coordinated with village panchayat officials to organize the program.

Starting from our university at 10:30 AM and arriving by 11:00 AM, we divided into groups to interact with villagers and understand their challenges during the rainy season. We discussed preventive measures such as drinking hot water, consuming protein-rich foods, maintaining personal hygiene, and ensuring cleanliness in the surroundings. Villagers also requested the application of bleaching powder along streets, which we promptly communicated to university authorities, who responded positively. Dr. K. S. R. Prasad, Dean of Student Affairs, presided over the program, with leadership from Mr. P. Srikanth Reddy, Dr. P. Yellamma, and coordination by Mr. P.Suresh.

Outcome:

The "Survey on Seasonal Diseases" conducted at Chirravuru village on 25-09-2021 achieved several outcomes.

1. **Increased Awareness:** The program successfully raised awareness among villagers about the causes, symptoms, and preventive measures of seasonal diseases such as Malaria and Dengue.
2. **Community Engagement:** Villagers actively participated in discussions and shared their health concerns, fostering a sense of community involvement in addressing health issues.
3. **Implementation of Solutions:** The request from villagers to spray bleaching powder along streets was conveyed to university officials, who responded positively, indicating proactive steps towards improving public health infrastructure.

Overall, the event contributed to better health education, community involvement, and potential improvements in public health practices in Chirravuru village.

Impact on Society:

The event on seasonal diseases at Chirravuru village significantly raised health awareness, empowering residents with knowledge on disease prevention and promoting proactive community health initiatives. It fostered a collaborative approach between villagers and authorities, potentially leading to improved health practices and conditions in the community.
