A Report on Swachh Bharat **Conducted at Pedapalem on 07-01-2022**

Objective:

The objective of the "Swachh Bharat" initiative conducted at Pedapalem on 07-01-2022 was to promote cleanliness and hygiene practices in the village. Organized under the national cleanliness campaign, the event aimed to mobilize community members, particularly youth and volunteers, to actively participate in cleaning public spaces, including streets, parks, and communal areas.
