Anti Ragging Act

Ragging of junior students is strictly banned. Any student found indulging in ragging of any form, will be summarily rusticated by the head of the institute. Ragging is a punishable offence under law and the student will be dismissed from the institute without any notice or warning and name may be reported to police for legal action.

Ragging in any form at any place is strictly prohibited

Punishments to those Involved in Ragging

- 1. Suspension from attending Classes
- withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any test or examination
- 4. Debaring from representing the institution in any meet, tournament, youth festival, etc
- 5. Suspension / Expulsion from the hostel
- 6. Cancellation of Admission
- 7. Withholding results
- 8. Rustication from the institution
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and debarring from admission to any other institution
