Feedback given by Alumni, Students, Industry Experts, Academic Peers and Parents were scrupulously observed and extensively discussed. Basing on the feedback, certain changes in the Programme Structure of Y19, Y20, Y21, Y22 and Y23 batches were deemed necessary.

- Replacing Aptitude for Advocacy II from Tenth Semester with “Human Rights Law and Practice” as a Core Course with Credits unchanged.

- To substitute the requirement for “Aptitude for Advocacy I” and “Aptitude for Advocacy II”, members of DAC agreed upon introducing ‘Quiz’ as a compulsory ALM, carrying a weightage of 15 marks in the Internal Evaluation Scheme. This would be more beneficial for the students to prepare for All India Bar Examination (AIBE).

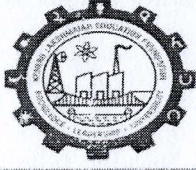

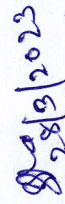
