YRC WORKSHOP FOR STUDENTS

OBJECTIVE:

The primary objective of the Youth Red Cross workshop was to educate and inspire students to become active agents of positive change in their communities. The specific goals of the workshop were as follows:

SUMMARY:

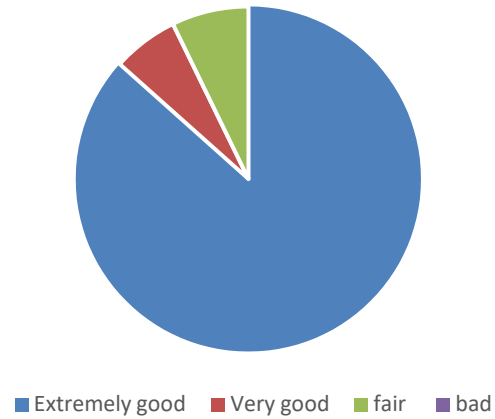

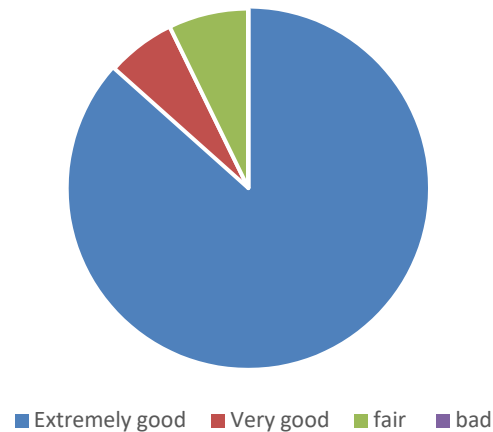

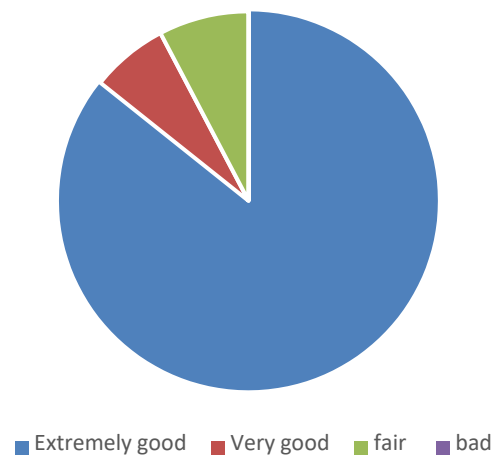
Rate the support offered by the physicians
