EVENT TITLE: ONEDAY WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID TRAINING

**OBJECTIVE** 

The primary objective of the First Aid Training program was to educate participants about basic first

aid techniques, promote a quick and appropriate response in emergencies, and build confidence in

providing immediate assistance to those in need.

**SUMMARY** 

Methodology:

**Planning:** The training program was developed by a team of qualified first aid instructors and

healthcare professionals. The curriculum was designed to cover fundamental first aid concepts,

including CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation), wound care, choking management, and handling

medical emergencies.

Target Audience: The training program targeted diverse groups, such as community members,

employees, teachers, parents, and individuals in various professions who may encounter

emergency situations. Training Sessions: The program was delivered through interactive training

sessions, combining theoretical knowledge with practical demonstrations. Training materials,

including training manikins, bandages, and medical supplies, were utilized to facilitate hands-on

learning experiences.

**Curriculum Highlights:** The training curriculum encompassed the following key areas:

Basic First Aid: Participants learned the principles of assessing and responding to injuries, burns,

fractures, bleeding, and shock.

CPR and AED (Automated External Defibrillator) Usage: Techniques for administering

cardiopulmonary resuscitation and using AED devices were taught, emphasizing the importance of

early intervention in cardiac arrest cases.

Choking Management: Participants acquired skills in identifying and responding to choking

incidents, including techniques for clearing airways.

**Medical Emergency Response:** First aid protocols for medical emergencies, such as seizures, allergic reactions, and asthma attacks, were covered to enable effective response and assistance.

**Practical Exercises:** Participants engaged in practical exercises to simulate emergency scenarios.

These exercises helped reinforce the application of learned skills and build confidence in real-life situations.

**Certification:** Upon successful completion of the training program, participants received certification or a completion card, acknowledging their proficiency in first aid skills. This certification is widely recognized and serves as a testament to their training and ability to provide immediate aid.

#### **Results and Impact:**

The First Aid Training program yielded the following outcomes:

**Increased Knowledge:** Participants gained comprehensive knowledge of basic first aid techniques, enabling them to respond effectively to emergencies and provide immediate assistance to those in need.

**Skill Development:** Practical exercises and hands-on training enhanced participants' ability to apply first aid techniques confidently.

**Improved Preparedness:** Participants acquired the necessary skills and knowledge to assess emergency situations and provide appropriate first aid interventions, potentially saving lives and reducing the severity of injuries.

**Community Empowerment:** The training program contributed to building a community that is better prepared to respond to emergencies, fostering a sense of safety and well-being.

#### **OUTCOMES:**

The First Aid Training program successfully equipped participants with essential life-saving skills, empowering them to respond effectively in emergency situations. By providing knowledge, practical training, and certification, the program contributed to improved preparedness, increased confidence, and enhanced community safety.

Continued efforts to offer first aid training to a wider audience are recommended to ensure a greater number of individuals have the skills necessary to respond promptly and effectively during emergencies, ultimately saving lives and reducing the impact of injuries.
