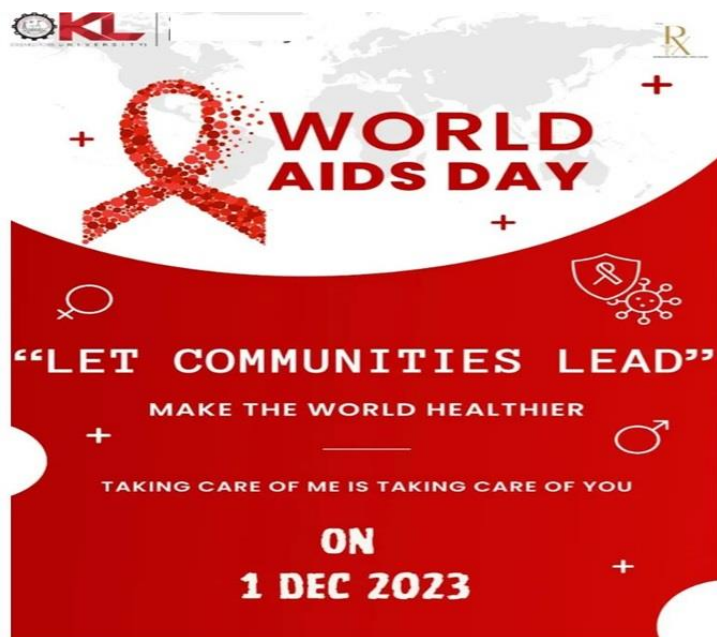

Objective:

The objectives of the AIDS Day rally organized by the students for the community are to:

- **Raise awareness:** Educate the community about HIV/AIDS, its transmission, prevention, and treatment options, dispelling myths and misconceptions.
- **Reduce stigma:** Challenge societal stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV/AIDS, promoting empathy and understanding.
- **Encourage testing:** Promote voluntary HIV testing and counseling services, enabling early diagnosis and access to care.
- **Promote safe practices:** Advocate for safe sexual practices, including condom use, and highlight the importance of harm reduction strategies.
- **Mobilize support:** Encourage community involvement and support for people living with HIV/AIDS, promoting a sense of solidarity and collective responsibility.
- **Advocate for policy change:** Advocate for policies that support comprehensive HIV prevention, treatment, and care services, ensuring equitable access for all.

Description:

On World AIDS Day, students organized a rally to raise awareness within the community, marching through local streets with banners, posters, and placards promoting HIV/AIDS education, prevention, and stigma reduction. Dressed in red—the color symbolizing AIDS awareness—they chanted slogans like "Know Your Status, Save Lives" and "Fight Stigma, Not People." Some students handed out informational pamphlets, educating people on safe practices, the importance of regular testing, and

the effectiveness of available treatments. Speakers, including healthcare professionals and community leaders, addressed the crowd at key stops, sharing personal stories and advocating for compassion toward those affected by HIV/AIDS. The rally aimed to break down misconceptions, inspire empathy, and encourage community members to support HIV-positive individuals with understanding and acceptance.

Procedure of the Event

1. The KLEF_YRC team arrived in the Tadepalli 10:30 am.
2. They commenced the event by explaining about the AIDS disease and its complications
3. Organized by the YRC volunteers from KL University

Outcome of the event:

The rally on AIDS Day organized by students brought meaningful outcomes for the community, highlighting the importance of awareness, support, and proactive health measures against HIV/AIDS. Through marches, posters, and engaging presentations, students provided valuable information about HIV prevention, treatment options, and the importance of getting tested, directly reaching people who may not have had access to such knowledge. The rally helped reduce stigma by openly discussing myths surrounding HIV/AIDS, emphasizing that people living with HIV deserve respect, support, and equal opportunities. Students encouraged community members to seek accurate information, debunking long-standing misconceptions and helping people understand that, with treatment, HIV can be managed effectively, allowing individuals to live long, healthy lives. The event also fostered empathy and solidarity, as community

members observed young people taking the initiative to raise awareness on a crucial issue that affects people globally. By mobilizing young voices, the rally energized the community to take personal responsibility for their health and seek ways to support those impacted by HIV/AIDS. The overall outcome was a more informed, unified community with greater compassion and a shared commitment to fighting HIV/AIDS stigma, potentially inspiring more health-driven initiatives in the future.
